IMPORTANT

Each participant:

- Is required to agree to and strictly follow the publication ethics of the conference.
- Must conform to the authors' guidelines and the Template provided by the organizers.
- Can **submit only two contributions** as a principal author while at least **one of the papers must be presented** (preferably by principal author or, if this is not possible, by another member of author's team).

All papers are required to state the measure of each author's contribution to the paper, while the principal author guarantees the clarity and accuracy of the information provided.

The **number of citations** within a paper **is limited to 15**; the relevancy of all literary references will be a part of the evaluation process (scientific round).

The peer review process is two-fold. First, the contribution must be found fit by a formal reviewer and only after this the paper is sent to a scientific reviewer (second round). The paper will be accepted only after passing successfully both rounds of evaluation process.

Owing to high volume of contributions, conference's renown, and its demanding's standards, we strongly advice any prospective participant to react to any reviewer's suggestions in a swift and responsible manner. As the review process time frame is limited, you are expected to comply with reviewers' remarks as soon as possible. Failing to accept the reviewers' comments within the time being allocated has unpleasant consequences: your contribution will not make it into the conference proceedings!
